

# NO HEALTH WITHOUT ORAL HEALTH

Oral health is the state of the mouth, teeth and orofacial structures that enables individuals to perform essential functions such as eating, breathing and speaking, and encompasses psychosocial dimensions such as self-confidence, well-being and the ability to socialize and work without pain, discomfort and embarrassment. Oral health varies over the life course from early life to old age, is integral to general health and supports individuals in participating in society and achieving their potential.


Poor oral health has direct links with other major health conditions including diabetes, heart attack, stroke, coronary heart disease, cardiac arrhythmia, premature births etc. Poor oral health also has a negative impact on the global economy. The world's economic burden of oral diseases totals \$710 billion annually.



Oral diseases, while largely preventable, pose a significant global health burden affecting 3.5 billion people globally, causing physical symptoms, functional limitations, and detrimental impacts on emotional, mental, and social well-being. These conditions combined have an estimated global prevalence of 45%, which is higher than the prevalence of any other NCD.

### UNIVERSAL HEALTH COVERAGE

Recognizing the global public health importance of major oral diseases and conditions, in May 2021, the World Health Assembly adopted a landmark resolution on Oral health (WHA74.5) highlighting that oral health should be embedded within the global NCD and UHC agendas. Based on the mandate outlined in the resolution, the Secretariat developed the Global strategy on oral health, adopted in May 2022 (decision WHA75(11)), and included the Global oral health action. plan 2023-2030 in the report on NCDs, noted by the Seventy-sixth World Health Assembly (WHA76(9)).





On the other hand, dental technology is evolving at an accelerated rate and the digitalization of all aspects in dental care is on the horizon. Some of the contemporary trends in the dental industry includes digital work flow with CAD-CAM Technology including 3D printing and AI technology with CBCT scans and cloud-based software solutions.

## DRIVING INNOVATIONS, ACCESSIBILITY, AND PROGRESS IN ORAL HEALTH AMIDST GLOBAL CHALLENGES AND EVOLVING TECHNOLOGIES







In 2023, the dynamic landscape of the global dental market share was USD 35.40 Billion in 2023 and it is projected to increase from 38.95 billion in 2024 to \$95.37 billion in 2030. The estimation for Africa's Dental care market size in 2022 was USD 538.21M and it is projected to reach USD 988.82m in 2030.

Tanzania, like many African countries is facing several barriers towards advancement of dental services. Some of the problems facing dental industry in the country is shortage of trained dental professionals, lack of equipment, infrastructure, technology and inadequate funding. As a results the majority of Tanzanian population have limited access to high quality dental healthcare.

To address the accessibility challenge, and in line with WHO vision of achieving universal health coverage (UHC), the government of Tanzania is committed to expand the delivery of oral health services in at least 20% of primary health facilities by 2030. Thus, in order to stay abreast in the dynamic world of evolving dental technology and creativity, Tanzania Dental Expo is committed to promote the advancement of dental technology, education, innovation and networking.
